

N.C 4th of July Festival
Non-Profit Information Booth Application

The N.C. 4th of July Festival will designate one 10x10 space per day (July 2-4) at Waterfront Park for non-profit organizations. The purpose of the space is to bring public awareness to the non-profit's services. A non-aggressive fundraising activity may take place in the confines of the booth as long as that activity does not resemble in any way a raffle drawing or lottery. To choose which 3 non-profit organizations will be invited to display on the Waterfront, the Festival will hold a drawing from the approved non-profit applications.

The charity will be allowed to erect a 10x10 tent with tables, chairs, and a reasonably sized banner in the space. **No raffle drawings or lotteries of any kind will be approved or allowed in this booth space.** We also prohibit distribution of any information that may be considered discriminatory, provocative or controversial in nature or campaigning for elected positions or referendums. A donation collection box is acceptable.

To qualify the organization must be:

- A North Carolina Charities
- A 501 (c) 3 Non-Profit Organization recognized by the United States Internal Revenue Service
- Active Website
- Brochure outlining services offered by the charity
